# **JA Innovation Challenge Program Overview**

JA Innovation Challenge immerses middle school students, grades 5-7, in the world of business by challenging them to develop a pitch for a new flavor of pizza for Pizza Joe's, targeted for a market of their peers. Students work together in teams to practice entrepreneurial thinking and experience the creativity, sense of accomplishment and excitement that comes with solving a real-world business challenge. - Video entries will be judged on: **INNOVATIVE IDEA**: is the pizza flavor achievable, **CREATIVITY**: tagline and visual advertisement, **DELIVERY**: the persuasiveness of the pitch, and **OVERALL QUALITY**: innovative pizza, pitch, tagline, cost, and advertisement.
- Complete the entry form and upload your video by 5:00 PM on Friday, April 28th, 2023.

# **HELPFUL HINTS**

- Practice is key. We do not want to see your team members reading from a sheet of paper.
- Be enthusiastic! Judges will be more interested in your idea if you are excited about it.
- We must be able to see your advertisement clearly in your video.
